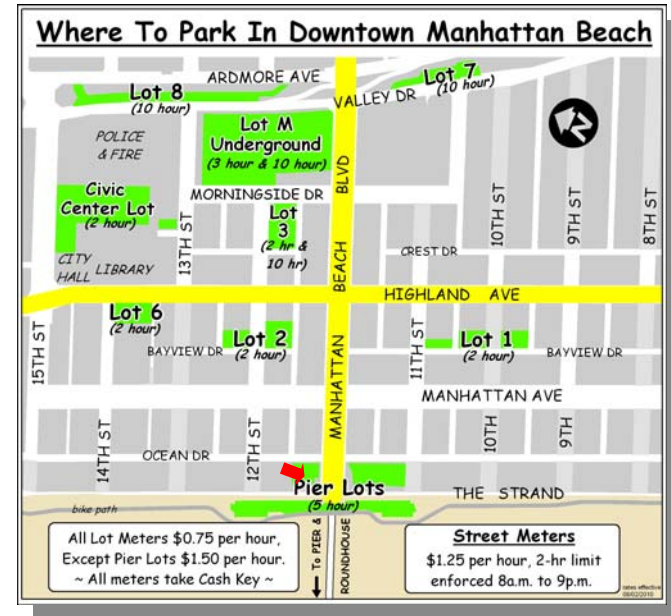

Exit the 405 Freeway at Rosecrans, go west for approximately one mile and turn left on Sepulveda Boulevard. Follow Sepulveda Boulevard for one mile to Manhattan Beach Boulevard and turn right. Follow Manhattan Beach Boulevard to the North Upper Pier Lot, at the northwest corner of Ocean Drive and Manhattan Beach Boulevard.

Valet parking will be available on Ocean and 12th for a flat rate of \$9.
